MASTER OF PROJECT MANAGEMENT (MPM) PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Master of Project Management (MPM) Program at College of Business Administration is the first master's program of its kind in Saudi Universities. The MPM at Dar Al Uloom University (DAU) is designed to be in conformity with the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBOK) developed by the Project Management Institute (PMI) and seeks to prepare students to take the PMI exam. Therefore, the MPM is ideal for professionals striving for career advancement in the field of project management or fresh graduates aiming to build a career in this field. The program is a two-years, 45 credit hours program, admitting students with bachelor's degrees in project management related fields such as Engineering, IT, and Business. However, applicants with degrees of unrelated disciplines can be individually considered for admission if they have relevant field work experience in project management but would be required to complete a set of 4 complementary courses.







ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to the Master of Project Management (MPM) program, an applicant will need to meet the following minimum requirements:

01

Have a bachelor's degrees in project management related fields such as Engineering, IT, and Business. Applicants with degrees of unrelated disciplines can be individually considered for admission if they have relevant field work experience of at least two years in project management but would be required to complete a set of complementary courses with a minimum standing of average "very good".

02

Submission of satisfactory score in the General Aptitude Test for University Graduates administered by Qiyas or equivalent exams such as GMAT or GRE taken within the last two years.

03

Submission of a minimum score of (5) in IELTS Exam or equivalent score in alternative exams such as Qiyas Standardized Test for English Proficiency (STEP) or TOEFL taken within the last two years.

04

Must pass a personal interview and the admission tests specified by the college.

05


